1. Eligibility

Category	Annual Income	Education
ST & SC	Annual income of the parents or guardians should not exceed ` 2 Lacs	ST/ SC/ OBC students continuing their Post matriculation studies successfully in any of the courses mentioned under Group I, II, III & IV in any Govt. or Recognized private institute
OBC	Annual income of the parents or guardians should not exceed ` 1 Lac
