No. 217 /M & BCW, Bhubaneswar, dated the 02-03-2012
OBC-114/11

Sub : Revision of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for students belonging to OBCs (PMS-OBC)

- 1.1. The State Government with financial support from Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment have implemented the scheme of Post-matric Scholarship for O.B.C. students. The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to O.B.C students studying at Post-matriculation or Post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.
- 1.2. In pursuance to Revision of Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for students belonging to OBCs w.e.f. 01.07.2011, by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India and communicated vide their letter No.11014/21/2006-BC-I, dt.11.08.2011, Govt. of Odisha revised the Resolution No. 76, dt.31st January,2006 in the following respects.
2. The scholarships shall be awarded to the students of OBC/ SEBC category for their study in Odisha. The OBC/ SEBC students prosecuting their study outside Odisha shall avail this scholarship w.e.f. the Financial year 2012-13.
3. **Changes** (i) income ceiling (ii) grouping of courses and rates of maintenance allowances and reimbursement of non-refundable compulsory fee as per Govt. approved rate (iii) procedure for application (iv) sanctioning Authority and (v) mode of disbursement.
 - i) Annual family income for availing Post-matric Scholarship (OBC) should not exceed Rs.1,00,000/-.
 - ii) Grouping of courses and rates of maintenance allowances and non-refundable compulsory fees.

- iii) **Procedure for application** the application forms should be submitted Online through e-Scholarship (Post-matric Portal) "**PRERANA**" introduced by ST&SC Development, Minority and Backward Classes Welfare Department, Odisha.
 - iv) **Sanctioning Authority** – District Welfare Officers shall verify and sanction or reject the applications received through Online and generate sanction order and forward to state.
 - v) **Mode of disbursement** : On receipt of funds from the Govt. the D.W.O. will submit the bill alongwith statement indicating details of student scholarship amount, account No., IFSC Code etc. to the concerned Treasury for drawal and Online disbursement to the students through the attached Treasury Bank.
4. The Scheme though was to begin with open - ended, in practice been implemented subject to Notional allocation available for it. This "Funds-Limited" nature is now formalized by Govt. of India.
- i) At the beginning of the financial year notional allocation (N.A) of the funds will be communicated by Govt. of India to the State Govt.
 - ii) State Govt. will sub-allocate the notional allocation district-wise and group-wise for all professional and non-professional courses.
 - iii) The criteria for selection of scholarship under both professional and non-professional courses to the extent of available funds is based on Merit-cum-Means.
 - iv) At least 25% of the total outlay under the scheme shall be earmarked for Group-D courses which include, Class-XI and XII and all other Post-matriculation level non-degree courses, diploma courses in polytechnics etc.
 - v) The funds so allocated shall be utilized to cover renewal cases (student already awarded scholarship during the previous year) first and balance amount shall be utilized to cover Fresh cases.
5. All other provisions of the scheme contained in this Deptt. Resolution No.76. dt.31.01.2006 remain unchanged.

This resolution shall be implemented w.e.f. 01.07.2011.
